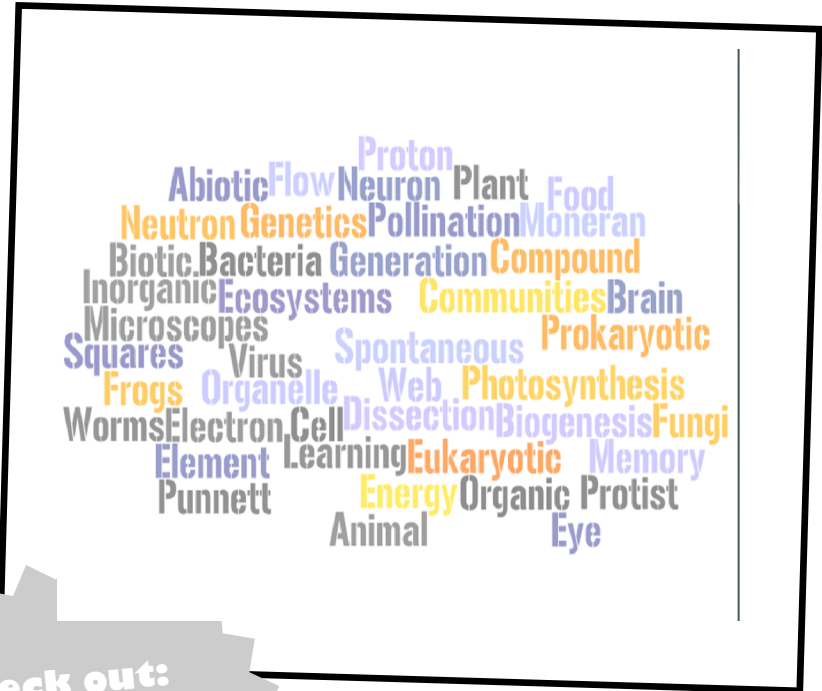

Binder Procedures: A Neat and Organized Notebook is the Key to Success in Science



Every student is to have a three ringed (1 ") binder divided into 2 sections & labeled as follows:

- A. Handouts (White paper handouts, homework, quizzes)**
- B. Science journal (Journal entries & notes)**
